1. Open Meeting

Bob Dixon opened the meeting at 8:00am with a roll call of board members and attendees.

2. Reading of the minutes from proceeding meeting

Debbie Trewitt read the minutes of the December board meeting.

3. Treasurer report

We are still owed \$36k by members for past due fees and assessments; two additional properties have been sent to Hindman-Sanchez this week to pursue lawsuits worth about \$8k of debt;; \$15k of that is from 2010 dues; we will continue to pursue those

Income

Total income of \$143k; total dues of \$136k are included in that number

Current assets: \$72k in cash in Wells Fargo

Reserves: \$10k and Capital Improvement \$3.5k (these are included in the \$72k of cash mentioned above)

5. Caretaker's Report

a. Progress Report

Work performed since last meeting:

- 1. Installed heat in the shop
- 2. Worked on equipment and did plow repairs
- 3. Fixed the upper and lower gates twice
- 4. Obtained a fire permit to burn the slash pile (they will do that this upcoming Wednesday 2/16)
- 5. Worked on the dump truck sander; one gear was rusted out because of lack of proper maintenance; they found used inserts for \$1,800-\$2,800; Darren will look at new inserts as well to determine the best solution
- 6. The backhoe has a bent rim so the tire won't hold air; it is in the BLE shop and they are working on it
- 7. Working on three rail chains for the dump truck
- 8. Snow removal
- 9. Daily sanding of roads
- 10. Two patrols daily
- 11. Loader & dump truck plows need new cutting edges

b. Snow plowing policy

There have been a number of complaints about berms blocking driveways and making it difficult to get in and out. Marty Stevenson will drive along with Paul and Darren after the next storm and give them some ideas on methods to more effectively clear member's driveways.

6. Architectural Control Committee (ACC) Report

None

Special note: the only approval method for building anything, removing trees, painting (if it is a different color), etc. is through the ACC. Any questions or concerns can be directed to the ACC committee. Forms, procedures, and covenants are posted on the BLE web site.

7. Miscellaneous

A. Road condition at bottom of hill

Ken Donoher, Paul, and Darren are going to meet with Jim Moyer to discuss a plan for upgrading the road/hillside near the bottom gate. They will present a plan at the April board meeting for approval and pending approval will perform the work in May.

B. Ditch to upper lake from near the slash pile

A new ditch will be dug and lined and the old ditch will be filled in.

C. Lakes and ice fishing

There has been discussion about members using the BLE lakes in the winter for ice fishing and other winter activities. There are a couple considerations regarding winter lake use: 1) Insurance coverage, and 2) The effect on the fish in the lower lake.

There was general consensus that we should not allow anyone on the lower lake in the winter. Signs will be posted accordingly.

It was proposed that ice fishing and other activities will be allowed on the upper lake with signs posted "Winter activities at your own risk".

Ken Donoher and the fishing committee will meet in the next couple weeks to discuss policies, wording for signs, timing, etc. They will follow-up with the board to put a final policy in place.
