

# FISHING GUIDELINES for the 2015 Season

## <u>SECTION 1 – GENERAL REQUIREMENTS</u>

These Fishing Guidelines are supplemental to the <u>Amended and Restated Declaration of Restrictive Covenants for Beaver Lakes Estates</u> and Beaver Lakes Estates Filing #2 (Covenants) recorded in the records of Lake County, Colorado and the <u>Amended General Club</u> Provisions and Rules & Regulations for the Area Known as Beaver Lakes Estates and Beaver Lakes Estates Filing No. 2.

These Fishing Guidelines apply to the two lakes in common areas of Beaver Lakes Estates and Beaver Lakes Estates Filing #2 including the Lower Lake and the Upper Lake (the Lakes). Fishing on rivers, streams, beaver ponds, and other aquatic areas are regulated by the State of Colorado.

## **SECTION 2 – DEFINITIONS**

- 1) <u>Members and their immediately family</u> Shall mean any Member(s) or Owner(s) immediate family. The terms Member(s) and Owner(s) may be used interchangeably.
- 2) Guests Shall mean a Guest of the Member that is not a tenant.
- 3) <u>Tenant</u> Shall mean any person or persons leasing a house or property from a Member for any length of time.

## **SECTION 3 – MEMBER AND GUEST FISHING SEASON GUIDELINES**

- 1) Members May 1st through October 31st.
- 2) <u>Guests (accompanied)</u> May 1st through October 31<sup>st</sup> as long as the Guest is accompanied by a Member on both the lower and upper lake.
- 3) Guests (unaccompanied) Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend on both the lower and upper lakes.
- 4) Tenant Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend on both the lower and upper lakes.
- 5) Children Fourteen (14) years and younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older at all times.
- 6) Hours Dawn to dusk (no night fishing)

## **SECTION 4 – BADGES**

- 1. <u>Member & Guest Badges</u> Will be available for order thru the Annual Dues mailing that comes out in March/April. Each household can order up to four (4) Member badges (red) and up to four (4) Guest badges (yellow). Up to two (2) more additional Guest Badges can be purchased at a cost of \$50.00 each. Lost badges within the first eight (8) badges listed above can be replaced at a cost of \$20 each by contacting fishing committee member.
- 2. <u>Tenant Badges</u> Will be available for order thru the Annual Dues mailing that comes out in March/April. Each household can order up to four (4) Tenant badges (orange) for a cost of \$250 each per year. Lost Tenant badges will cost \$100 each to replace by contacting fishing committee member.
- 3. <u>Member and Guest badges</u> may never be used for a commercial gain.
- 4. Badges must be visible at all times while fishing.

## **SECTION 5 – FISHING RULES**

- 1) Record number of fish kept at the upper lake at the kiosk.
- 2) Flotation devices or watercraft of any kind are not allowed on the Lakes.

- 3) Do not access or interfere with the Lakes spillway structures.
- 4) Do not park on the dams or roadways. Park in designated areas only. Parking at the Lower Lake is located west of the dam. Parking on the Upper Lake is located east of the dam. Do not park in front of driveways or Owners' lots.
- 5) The use of waders is permitted. Disinfect waders and rinse off before entering the lakes by using an all-purpose cleaner such as Formula 409. Spray the entire outside portion and bottoms of waders and scrub completely.
- 6) Remove and dispose of all fish kills.
- 7) Remove all fish line snags, trash, and debris.
- 8) Chumming is not allowed on either Lake.

# SECTION 6 - METHODS OF FISHING

### Lower Lake

- 1) All fishing shall be catch and release. Do not take fish from lake.
- 2) Flies and lures are allowed only. Only 1 treble hook on a lure is allowed.
- 3) All hooks will be barbless or have barbs crimped.

## Upper Lake

- 1) Fish limit is 2 Rainbow Trout per person per day. There is no limit on Brook Trout.
- 2) Flies and lures are allowed only. Only 1 treble hook on a lure is allowed.
- 3) We encourage the use of barbless hooks for those intending to catch and release fish.

## **SECTION 7 – RELEASING FISH**

- 1) Use barbless hooks or hooks with barbs crimped.
- 2) Wet Hands before handling or releasing fish.
- 3) Avoid playing fish to exhaustion.
- 4) Revive fish before releasing.

#### SECTION 8 – ENFORCEMENT OF FISHING RULES - MEMBERS & GUESTS

- 1) 1st Offense A written warning will be issued to member.
- 2) Each additional violation will result in a \$250.00 fine to the member
- 3) Any commercial use of a member or guest badge will result in a \$1,000 fine and loss of fishing privileges for a 2 year period.
- 4) Anyone Witnessing a Fishing Violation Please Contact the Manager

## **SECTION 9 – ENFORCEMENT OF FISHING RULES - TENANTS**

- 5) 1st Offense \$500 fine to Member who sponsored (leased) to Tenant.
- 6) 2nd Offense Tenant Badges revoked for remainder of the current fishing year and the subsequent year (one) fishing season.
- 7) Anyone Witnessing a Fishing Violation Please Contact the Manager

Anyone fishing who is not a member, guest of a member or tenant will be considered a trespasser and the sheriff will be notified.
